

THE WATERFORD POOL RULES

1. Hours are from 6:00 AM until 11:00 PM. Premises must be vacated at closing.
2. Entrance for members is by access card only.
3. In case of emergency, call 911. Telephone located on rear of clubhouse. If an injury occurs at the pool or deck, please call 911 immediately and (678) 315-0242 promptly thereafter.
4. Children age 12 and under must be accompanied by a person age 16 or older.
5. Children three years old and younger, as well as any child not potty trained, must wear snug fitting plastic pants or a water resistant swim diaper.
6. If any child requires the use of a personal floatation device and cannot swim, a responsible person must supervise such child and always be within arm's reach of the child.
7. Shower and rinse thoroughly before entering the pool.
8. NO glass articles, breakable containers, sharp objects or hazardous materials allowed in or around pool.
9. NO animals are allowed in the pool area at any time (except canine assistance is permitted in the deck area).
10. NO food, drink or wrappers allowed within ten feet (10') of the pool.
11. NO diving into the pool.
12. Trash and litter must be promptly disposed of and placed in designated containers.
13. Persons with open cuts, wounds, sores, rashes, blisters, open lesions or other potentially hazardous conditions or any communicable condition may not use the pool. Any and all bandages must be removed before entering the pool. Do not swim if you had diarrhea within the past two weeks.
14. NO alcoholic beverages may be consumed in or around the pool area by persons under the age of 21, and any person who consumes alcohol in the pool area must do so responsibly.
15. Intoxicated individuals shall not be permitted in the pool or on the deck. For the purpose of this rule, persons shall be considered "intoxicated" if they appear to be inebriated or have consumed sufficient alcoholic beverages such that they would be considered legally drunk if operating a motor vehicle in the State of Georgia. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, under no circumstances shall the Association be liable for the actions of intoxicated individuals or the failure to remove an intoxicated individual from the pool or deck.
16. NO smoking or use of other tobacco products or e-cigarettes is permitted in the pool or deck area.
17. NO gum allowed in pool or in deck area.
18. NO spitting, spouting or blowing nose in pool.
19. NO running, pushing, dunking, horseplay, or other disorderly conduct is permitted at any time. Any person engaging in any of the foregoing may be required to immediately leave the area.
20. Solo swimming is discouraged
21. Do not swim if the suction outlets are missing, broken, or not clearly visible from the deck.
22. If an accident involving bodily fluids or excrement occurs in the pool or deck, please notify (678) 315-0242 immediately.
23. NO swimming allowed during heavy rain or when thunder and lightning can be seen or heard.
24. Swimmers shall wear swimming attire. NO "cut-offs" or street clothes allowed in the pool.
25. NO bikes, roller blades, scooters, skateboards, hoverboards, or like items allowed in pool area, or on the sidewalks around the common areas.
26. NO electric devices with cords may be used. Music from battery operated radios, phones, etc. must be maintained at a volume that does not disturb others.
27. Lower umbrellas when not in use.
28. Pool area gate must be kept securely closed at all times other than when being used for entry and exit.
29. Pool is for the exclusive use of Waterford HOA members and their accompanied guests. Maximum of 4 guests per member.
30. Clubhouse or cabana rental does not include exclusive use of the pool or shade cabana.
31. Members and guests must comply with any request by a pool monitor or vacate the premises.

Vandalism, disruptive behavior, or failure to follow Pool Rules or instruction of a pool monitor will result in any or all of the following: expulsion from the pool area, suspension of member's amenities privileges, fines, criminal charges being filed.
